		*Attendance during the school breaks is not mandatory and you are not charged after school fees. Separate registration and payment is required to attend the camps.	

Payment: Weekly fees are to be paid in advance on Monday of the current week and are due, whether the child is present or not, in order to keep your reserved spot in the program. Payments that have been set up automatically, through a credit card, debit card, or bank draft, will be processed on Monday of the current week. A late fee of \$10 will be added if payment is not received by 6:00pm on Wednesday. Any balance still showing on Friday will automatically bill to the back-up payment method on file. All books will be cleared every Friday. Any account not current after 2 weeks will be suspended, and full payment must be made, plus any late fees and fees associated with attempts to collect payment, before the child can be accepted back into the program. Please contact the office at 615/754-8650 with any questions.

Schedule: We follow the Wilson county school calendar for holiday closings, snow days, fall, winter and spring break, and summer vacations but we make every attempt to support our Metro students. For our Andrew Jackson families we will communicate any updates to the Metro school calendar as necessary.

Hours: We are open from 2:00 until 6 PM during the school year. During vacation weeks and scheduled days off, we are open from 6:30 AM to 6 PM. If school is closed for a weather related event, we will be open from 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM, unless otherwise communicated through group email or text. A late fee of \$1.00/minute will apply for parents picking up later than 6:00 PM. Please be prepared to pay on arrival.

Voluntary Withdrawal: Once you enroll your child in the Langford Farms After School program you are reserving a spot for that child for the school year. Any adjustments to participation in the program must be made, in writing or via email, at least 1 week in advance. Payment is required during that time.

Closings: The After School program will be closed on the following days for the 2017/18 school year: Calendar subject to change.

Re-Enrollment: Families will be asked to submit paperwork for the upcoming school year in order to re-enroll in the program. Current families, and siblings, will be offered first opportunity and will have a deadline in the spring. After the deadline, we will begin accepting any new families. Participation is dependent on transportation from school availability, as well as program and age-group availability.



Homework Policy: We recognize the importance of getting homework done but ultimately it is the responsibility of each child. Our aim is to support this part of a child's education by providing a designated time, space, supplies if necessary and supervision. If a child does not have homework they may also read at book at this time. Due to space limitations it is not possible to have children do their work privately.

Playground and Outdoors: Every day, weather permitting, children in the program will play outdoors on the playgrounds or in the fields. Please be sure to plan accordingly and dress your children for the weather. All children will go outdoors if they attended school that day.

Snacks: Langford Farms provides an afternoon snack every day upon arriving at the program. We provide water and/or juice with their snack. If your child has a food allergy, please be sure to note that on their health form. On extended days, please be sure to provide a morning snack and lunch. During camp weeks, please provide a morning and afternoon snack as well as lunch. We do not have the ability to refrigerate or heat lunches.

Behavior Management: At Langford Farms our focus is on promoting the spirit of cooperation and mutual respect among the children. The staff uses positive reinforcement and redirection when necessary to help children with inappropriate behavior. If this initial attempt does not work, a child will be asked to sit out in order to calm down. Younger children will sit out between three and up to 10 minutes. Older children who can communicate their needs will rejoin the group when they feel they are ready, and after an appropriate amount of time to consider their actions. Staff will discuss why the behavior was inappropriate with the child and methods to try in order to prevent a reoccurrence in the future. If the disruptive behavior continues, the parent will be informed and their cooperation requested.

Termination and Suspension Policy: Children enrolled in the Langford Farms After School program, and their parents, are asked to support and follow our program rules and policies. These rules are designed to be fair, reasonable and age-appropriate. The rules are necessary in order the program to be a positive environment for all, and to ensure that everyone has a good time and remains safe.

Reasons for suspension and termination include:

- Physical or verbal abuse towards staff or other children
- Willful destruction of Langford Farms Club property
- Leaving the program without permission
- Endangering self or others
- Non-payment of tuition as described in "Rates" section

Seasonal Swimming: As part of the After School program, children will swim while the pools are open. Age appropriate groups will swim together and a schedule of days and times will be provided. Children must have a swimsuit to change into. Street clothing will not be allowed in the pools. A separate bag for their swimsuit and towel will help keep school work from getting wet.

Illness and Injury: Minor injuries (ie. nose bleeds, abrasions) will be treated by staff. In the event of a more serious injury, we will notify you immediately and treat the injury on-site, or if necessary, seek outside treatment. For a child who displays symptoms of illness, significant behavior change, or is visibly uncomfortable, parents will be contacted to take the child home. For the sake of all other children and staff, Langford Farms cannot provide care for sick children. While your child is waiting, we will provide necessary care.

Personal Belongings: After School scheduled programming runs until 5:30. From 5:30 – 6:00 children may use a small, personal item brought from home until parents come to pick up.

Absences and Notification: Please notify the club, via phone or email, if your child will be absent from the After School program. Examples: if a child is sent home sick from school, if a child stays home from school due to illness, has a doctor appointment, field trip, etc. Failure to notify us of your child's absence results in a delay for the buses as we must check with the school until we can determine the reason for the missing child. To assist with notification, we will also have a Long Term Calendar for parent notification of absences in advance, located in the check-out area of the club.
