Lower Camp: Completed Grades K – 2 nd	A unique camp environment created specifically for our younger children, under the close supervision of our counselors. Extended Care: The LFC camp programming runs from 8:30 – 4:30, however, you may drop your child off as early as 6:30am and pick them up as late as 6:00pm. There is no additional charge for early and/or after care. During the early and after care hours, the children are in a large, supervised area and are welcome to bring a personal item, such as a small toy, book, electronic toy, etc. to play with. We do not provide entertainment for the children at these times. Personal items are not allowed to be used during the regular camp programming.

****Weekly Payments:** Weekly payments will be set up as automatic withdrawals from either a credit or debit card, or bank draft. These payments will be processed the Friday *BEFORE* each week of camp that your child is registered for, unless we have already received payment, via any payment method, by 12:00 noon prior to billing.

Deposits and Registration: A camp spot is reserved with a \$55 non-refundable registration fee for each camper plus a \$25 deposit/week/child, at the time of registration. Deposits are applied to the weekly camp tuition fee. Deposits will be fully refunded if cancellation is made before May 15th. After May 15th, non-attendance may result in a forfeiture of your deposit if we were not able to find a replacement for your child's camp reservation.

Enrollment: Langford Farms Club accepts enrollment on a first come, first served basis. Registration is complete when we have received the registration form, health form, and registration fee and deposit, per child. Upon receipt and completion of camper registration, a confirmation email will be sent. If a particular camp group or week is full, you will be notified of the opportunity to place your child on a wait list. Important camp information will be sent out to all families in May. We do not offer partial week or single day pricing.

Payment: **Weekly tuition balances are due, in full, on or before the Friday prior to the start of each camp week.** You are also welcome to pay the camp balance any time prior to the due date, via any payment method. Please refer to the tuition payment schedule for weekly due dates. If pre-payment has not been made, payments will be processed on Friday for the upcoming camp week. If we are unable to process your payment you will be notified. Resolution of declined payments must be completed within 3 days, including all any fees, in order to continue participation in the program.

Schedule Adjustments:

We understand scheduling changes can occur and will do our best to accommodate your requests.

Adding Weeks: To add a week, please fill out the **Camp Change Form** and submit your request to the camp office at least 1 full week in advance. A week may be added only if space is available. A deposit will be required to add a week of camp.

Transferring Weeks: To transfer a week for which you originally registered, submit your request via the **Camp Change Form**. Your deposit may transfer to another week if space is available, and the request must be submitted for approval at least one week in advance for consideration. Only 1 deposit may be applied to any camp week.

Non-Attendance: If your child does not attend a week of camp that was reserved for you, and at least 1 week prior notification was not given and approved, your deposit will not be refunded or transferred and your payment will not be refunded or transferred

Cancellations: If cancellation is requested, via the **Camp change Form**, at least 1 week prior to your reserved camp week, the Friday processing will not occur, however, the deposit is non-refundable if the request has been made after May 15th. We do not issue credit for individual days missed or refund or transfer deposits if your child does not attend camp.

Camp Hours: Camp programming begins at 8:30am and ends at 4:30pm. Extended care hours open at 6:30am and close at 6:00pm. A late pick-up fee of \$10 per occurrence will be charged if a child is picked up after 6:00. Please be prepared to pay when you arrive.

Drop-off/Pick-up: All children must be signed in and out each day at the office. Campers may be signed out, by an adult over the age of 18, and only to those adults indicated on the authorized pick-up list, or with written parental permission given in advance.

Parent Handbook: Information on how to prepare your child for camp and general information regarding the Langford Farms camp program will be forwarded to all camp families, via email, in May. Please feel free to contact the office if you have any specific questions.
